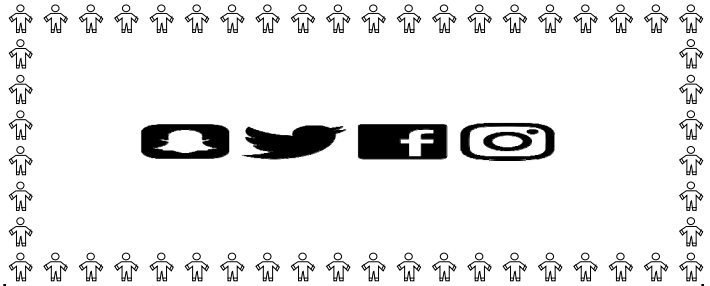
Prayer of the Trinity

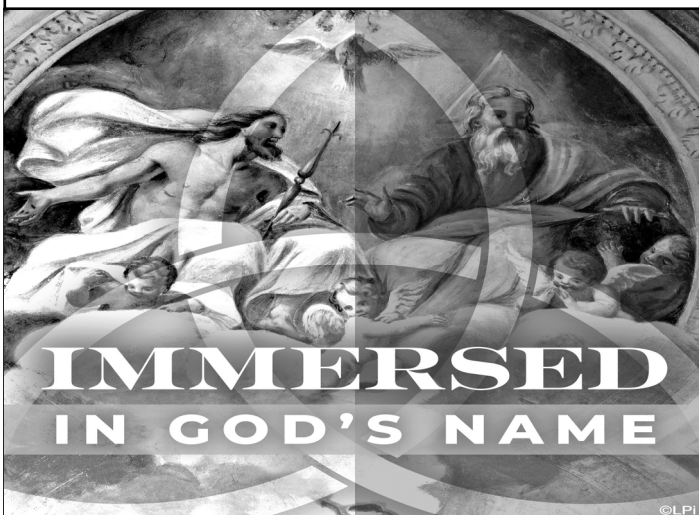
GOSPEL MEDITATION

May 26, 2024
The Most Holy Trinity

Once I was at a meeting with representatives of various religions. On a coffee break, a man from another religion mused to me: “You know, with all our differences, all religions are really about being good people.” I lowered my cappuccino and said as warmly as I could, “That’s not what mine’s about.” His quizzical look begged for clarification. “Mine is about plunging into the life of God,” I said. Just before Jesus ascends into heaven, he commands the eleven apostles, “Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.” (Matthew 28:19-20). The word “baptize” means “to immerse in, to plunge into.” It presupposes the use of water. But what does it mean to be immersed in God’s name? In the Bible, God’s name is identical to God Himself. So, to be baptized into water, using Jesus’ formula, is to be plunged into the life of God. Said another way, it is to die with Jesus and rise with him as a member of his body.

The Trinity isn’t a doctrine simply to accept and ponder. It’s more like an ocean: a mystery into which we are baptized ... inserted, immersed, dunked, plunged. Baptism gives us power to live our lives as beloved children of God, patterned after Jesus himself, who is always with us, until the end of the ages. Hardly the same as being good people. Stranger, but much better.

MEDITACIÓN EVANGÉLICO

26 de mayo de 2024
La Santísima Trinidad

Gloria al Padre, gloria al Hijo, y gloria al Espíritu Santo. “Vayan, pues, y hagan que todos los pueblos sean mis discípulos. Bautícenlos en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo, y enséñenles a cumplir todo lo que yo les he encomendado a ustedes” (Mateo 28 19-20). El misterio de Dios es la Santísima Trinidad y es el misterio central de la fe y de la vida cristiana. Todos estamos llamados a salvarnos y a conocer la verdad (1 Timoteo 2:4). La fe de todos los cristianos se cimenta en la Santísima Trinidad (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica número 232).

“Dios mío, Trinidad que adoro, ayúdame a olvidarme enteramente de mí mismo para establecerme en ti, inmóvil y apacible como si mi alma estuviera ya en la eternidad; que nada pueda turbar mi paz, ni hacerme salir de ti, mi inmutable, sino que cada minuto me lleve más lejos en la profundidad de tu Misterio. Pacífica mi alma. Haz de ella tu cielo, tu morada amada y el lugar de tu reposo. Que yo no te deje jamás solo en ella, sino que yo esté allí enteramente, totalmente despierta en mi fe, en adoración, entregada sin reservas a tu acción creadora” (Oración de Santa Isabel de la Trinidad. Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica número 260). Nunca tratemos de descifrar el Misterio de la Trinidad, más bien dejemos llevar nuestra alma en la oración como Santa Isabel de la Trinidad. Ella fue una religiosa y mística francesa de la Orden de los Carmelitas Descalzos.

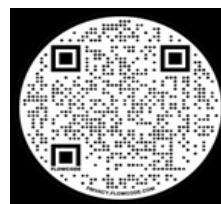
